PASADENA AREA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT TO THE PASADENA CITY COLLEGE FACULTY ASSOCIAITON August 30, 2021 Fall Semester 2021 Return to Campus Agreement Non-Instructional Faculty

The parties enter into this Supplemental Agreement in their continued response to the COVID-19 epidemic to (1) continue to follow public health directives, guidance, and practices, (2) maintain the continuity of the return and (3) ensure faculty are adequately supported so as to enable this transition.

 This Agreement is effective and covers work performed beginning August 23 through December 12, 2021. Should the need for this Side Letter Agreement to extend beyond Fall Semester 2021, nothing in this agreement shall be precedent setting in future situations, nor will not bind the Parties in any future action, whether under similar circumstances or not, and cannot be introduced in any grievance, arbitration, complaint, administrative, or legal proceeding as evidence of past practice or intent of the Parties or meaning or application of the collective bargaining agreement. To the extent this Agreement contains new terms, it supersedes the parties' COVID Emergency Agreements.

 During Fall 2021 semester, non-instructional faculty may be required to work face to face on campus, or another assigned location as long as it is safely conducive to the discharge of their responsibilities. All non-instructional faculty will be assigned to workspaces that provide allowances for personal social distancing. After September 30, student vaccination status will be verified before services are provided in-person one on one non-instructional settings. For individuals who are unvaccinated and seeking assistance, the college will provide services remotely.

Counselors, Librarians, and all other non-instructional faculty shall work 4 days a week on-site., 50% of which may be remotely on-site.

In the library, the District will ensure building capacity of 50 percent occupancy rates.

The district will train personnel to review students ability to be on campus for face to face personal non instructional services. From the date of this signed MOU through September 30, 2021, students seeking services from non instructional faculty will be required to show approval to the districts trained personnel, via the Qualtrics app, indicating they are vaccinated and non symptmotic at the time of requested services. Students not approved for face to face non instructional services via the Qualtrics app, will be allowed to submit a recent negative COVID 19 test (within 3 days) to qualify for face to face services. In instances where students do not have a negative COVID 19 test and are not vaccinated they will be able to receive services remotely.

For all faculty (non-instructional and instructional) who serve students face-to-face in an instructional, counseling, or library service on campus, the District shall pay an additional \$50.00 per day for the days worked in the above defined capacities.

For faculty providing proof of full vaccination status by September 30, 2021 the District will compensate the member \$500.00. Any sequential submission after September 30, 2021, will be reduced monthly by \$200.

Miscellaneous:

Compensation granted pursuant to this MOU shall not be creditable/pensionable compensation for purposes of CalSTRS reporting.

The Parties acknowledge and understand that the purpose of the compensation detailed herein is to support and encourage efforts to fight the spread and transmission of COVID-19 at the District.
