

Public Feeder High School Report

Technical Notes

The source of all data for these reports is the PCC Student Records database.

Students included in these reports indicated on their PCC application that they graduated from your high school in the specified year. To be counted, they must have enrolled beyond the third week in at least one credit course at PCC during the specified academic year(s); see below.

Major Public Feeder High School figures are also shown for comparison purposes. This group includes students from all the following high schools, including your own:

High School GPA. PCC's application for admission asks students to report their high school GPA by selecting one of the four ranges shown. Many students do not complete this item.

PCC GPA. Students' actual PCC grade point averages in courses for the relevant period were calculated and grouped into the ranges shown. Students whose enrollments consisted entirely of grades that do not affect GPA calculations (withdrawals [W], incompletes [I], credit [CR], and no credit [NC]) are excluded. For this reason, the total number of students reported for this item may be lower than the total number of graduates.

Educational Goal. This item comes from PCC's application for admission. The "Job Skills/Career Plans" category includes students who indicated that their educational goal was to acquire job skills, update job skills, or formulate career plans. Students whose educational goal is unknown are excluded.

PCC Units. All enrollments past the third week of classes (even those resulting in W, I, CR, or NC grades) are included in the calculation of units.

Grade Distributions. This section counts all enrollments past the third week of classes. For example, one student enrolled in three transferable courses is counted three times in that category.

PCC GPA, PCC Units, and Grade Distributions are calculated for the applicable cohort of high school graduates from the Summer term of their graduation year through the most recently completed Spring semester. Thus, since Spring 2007 is the most recently completed Spring semester, these tables reflect two full academic years for 2005 graduates (Summer 2005 through Spring 2007), or one full academic year for 2006 graduates (Summer 2006 through Spring 2007).

Some students took classes at PCC before they graduated from high school. These enrollments are excluded from this report.
