

Six ARCC College-level Performance Indicators

1. Improve the percentage of first-time PCC students who within 6 years:
 - Transfer to a 4-year college.
 - Earn an AA/AS degree
 - Earn an 18 unit certificate
 - Achieve “transfer-directed” status, or
 - Achieve “transfer-prepared” status

2. Improve the percentage of first-time PCC students who within 6 years complete 30 units while in the community college system.

3. Improve the percentage of first-time PCC students with a minimum of 6 units earned in their first term (not including PE courses), who enroll in a credit course in their second year in the community college system.

4. Improve the annual percentage of PCC students who successfully complete their vocational courses.

5. Improve the annual percentage of PCC students who successfully complete their credit basic skills courses.

6. Improve:
 - a. the percentage of PCC students who successfully complete at least one basic skills course and who then successfully complete a higher level basic skills course, or
 - b. the percentage of PCC students who successfully complete at least one credit or non-credit ESL course and who then successfully complete a higher level ESL course or college level course in the same group within 2 years of the first ESL course.
