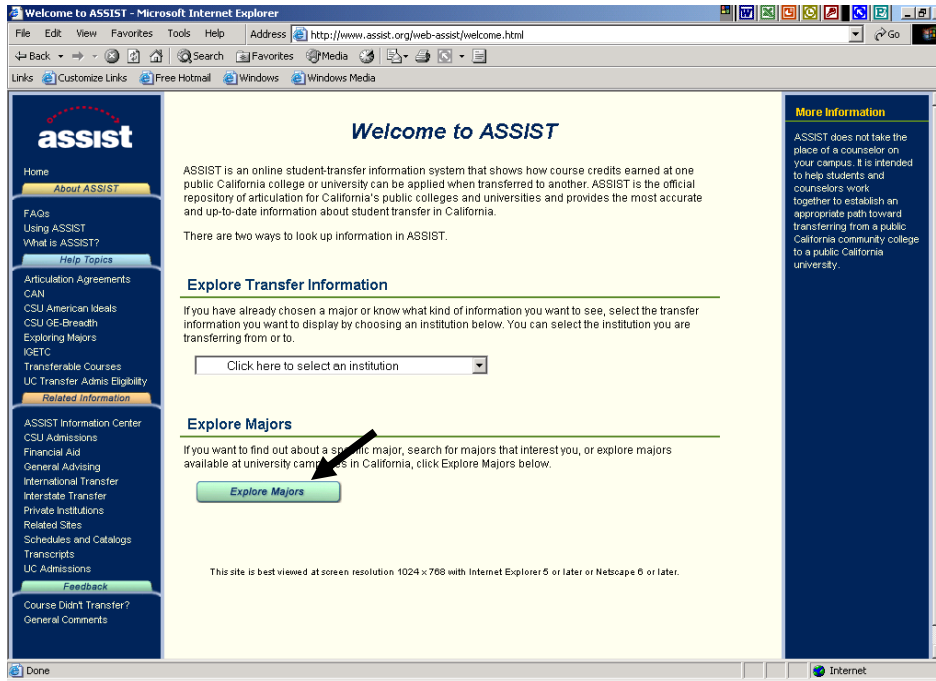
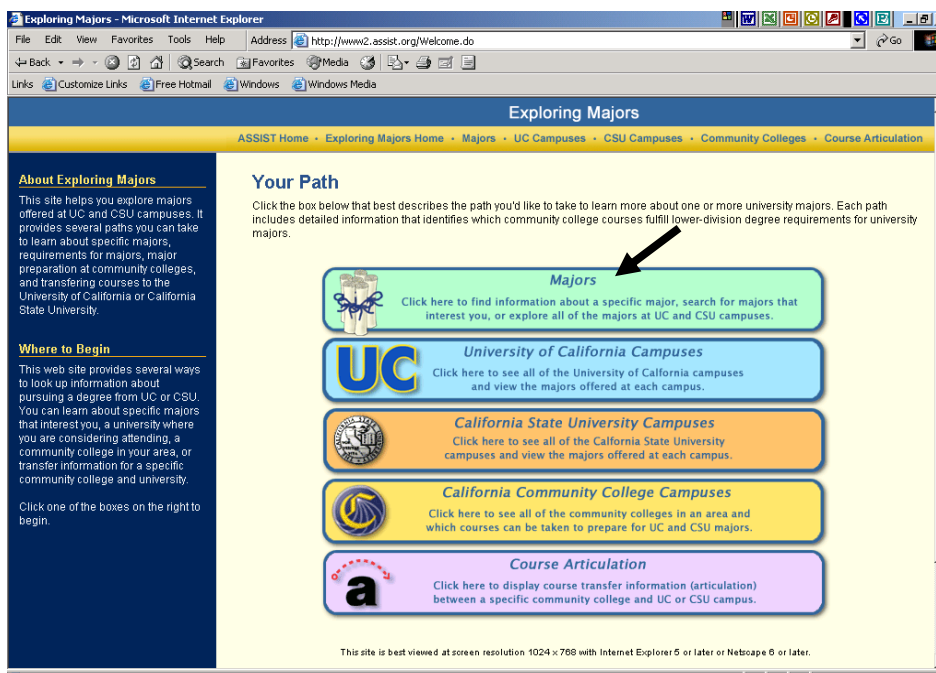


How to look up transfer major requirements by majors for the UC's or CSU's.

→ click on **Explore Majors**



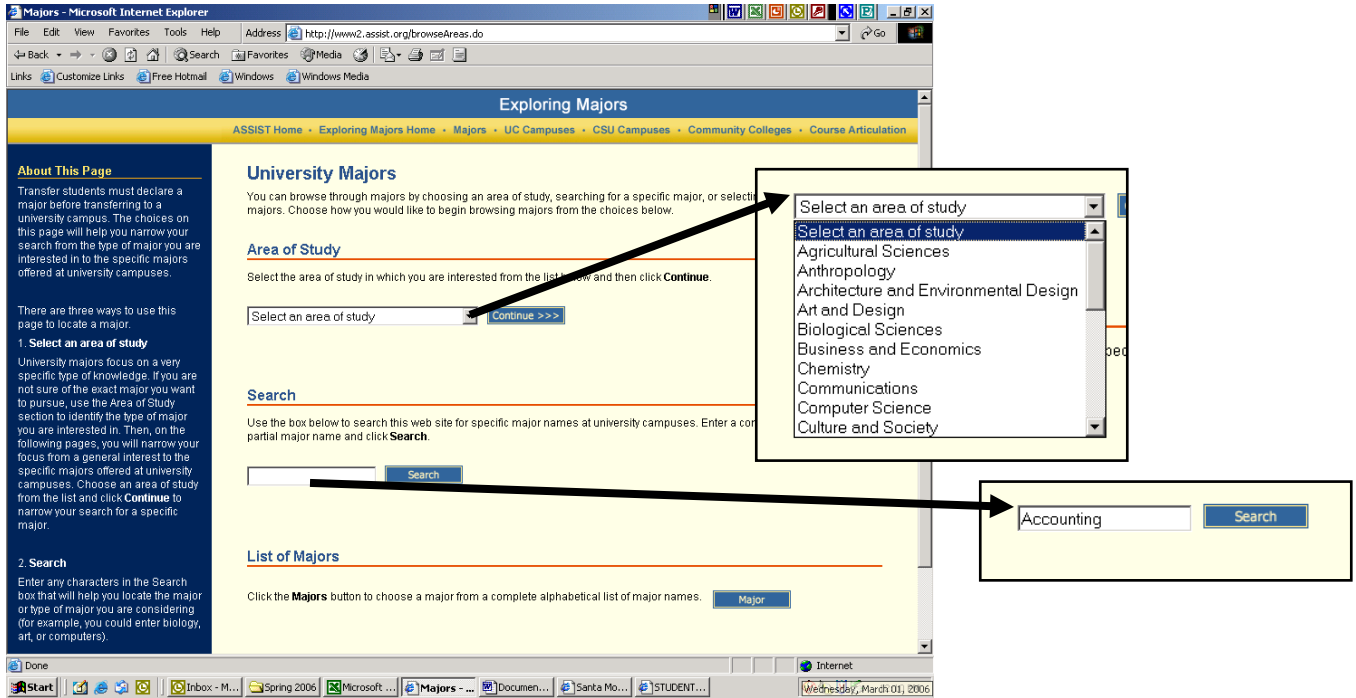

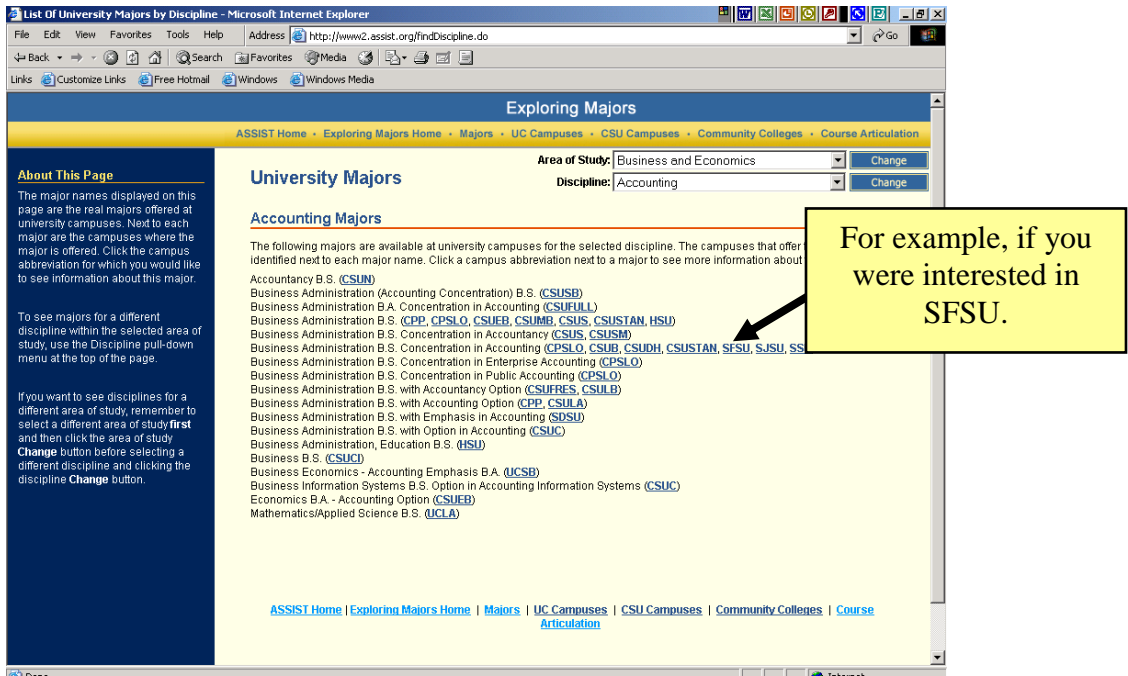
Either choose

It satisfies the requirements established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA) for the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) examination. The accounting program develops an understanding of an organization's management information system on a broad base of general education and business administration. The program is carefully planned and rigorous, building the conceptual, analytical, and communication skills necessary to succeed in the accounting profession. It prepares students for careers in the accounting profession, including the necessary qualifications for professional examinations such as the C.P.A., C.M.A., C.I.A.

This is an impacted program. Requires a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.90. ACCTG 201 and 202; FIN 240; IDS 180; ECON 101 and 102; MATH 120 (or other approved calculus); and either STAT 119 or ECON 201 must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. These courses cannot be taken for credit/no credit.
