Application to the college
Complete and submit an application to the college for admission if you are not a current student at PCC. For more information contact (626) 585-7395.

Application to the Dental Assisting Program
Complete an application and submit to the Health Sciences Division Office U202. Applications are accepted anytime. Applications may be mailed or hand delivered to the Health Sciences Division Office. See address below for mailing purposes. Faxed applications are not accepted.

Schedule an Appointment
Once you have submitted both applications and have been accepted by PCC for admission and your transcripts are on file in the Health Sciences Division, schedule an appointment with the program director at (626) 585-7542. The program director's office is located in Building R, room 508.

Registration
Upon acceptance into the Dental Assisting Program, you will receive an acceptance packet with detailed registration information. Be prepared to pay registration fees at the time of registration. For more specific information on the registration process please contact (626) 585-7575.

Bloodborne Pathogens
In accordance with Standard 5.1 as set forth by the American Dental Association Commission on Dental Accreditation, and in an effort to minimize risk to students and staff, we strongly encourage that all students obtain immunization against infectious diseases (mumps, measles, rubella, and Hepatitis B). Each student accepted into the program must have completed and returned the PCC Health Clearance form prior to the first day of classes.

CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation)
