CITIZEN AND ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZEN VERIFICATION

Federal Law requires that to receive financial aid the student must be either a United States citizen or an eligible non-citizen. The US Department of Education has asked Pasadena City College (PCC) to verify your status. Please complete the certification statement below and attach clear photocopies of the indicated documentation. Your documents will be submitted by PCC to the Bureau of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (formerly INS) for confirmation. Please check the appropriate box below.

CITIZEN BORN IN THE UNITED STATES

Attach a copy of your U.S. Birth Certificate or U.S. Passport.

CITIZEN NOT BORN IN THE UNITED STATES

- Attach a copy of your form FS-240: "Report of Birth Abroad of a U.S. Citizen bearing the embossed seal including the words "United States of America" and "State Department"; or
- Attach a copy of your Certificate of Citizenship; or
- Attach a copy of your Certificate of Naturalization; or
- Attach a copy of your U.S. Passport.

NON-CITIZEN NATIONALS (natives of American Samoa or Swain's Island), or **Permanent Residents Of The Northern Mariana Islands**, or **The Trust Territory Of The Pacific Islands** (eligibility limited to grant aid, and not eligible for student loans):

Attach a copy of your U.S. Birth Certificate or Passport

U.S. PERMANENT RESIDENTS

- Attach copies of BOTH SIDES of your Alien Registration Receipt card (I-151, I-551 or I-551C); or
- Attach a copy of your passport, valid through first day of classes, stamped "Processed for I-551..." including a copy of the picture identification page; or
- Attach a copy of your Departure Record (Form I-94) valid through the first day of classes, stamped "processed for I-151..." showing the expiration date, or stamped "Temporary form I-551" showing the expiration date.

OTHER ELIGIBLE NON-CITIZENS

- Attach a copy of your "Arrival-Departure Record" (Form I-94) with a stamp indicating one of the following:
 - a. "Refugee"
 - b. "Asylum Granted"
 - c. "Indefinite Parole" and/or "Humanitarian Parole"
 - d. "Cuban-Haitian entrant, Status Pending"

NOTE: You are NOT ELIGIBLE to receive federal student aid if you are OR have a letter that states you are one of the following:

- An applicant for permanent resident status and not in a category listed above;
- A student with an F1 or F (student), J1 or J2 (exchange visitor) or L or G series visa;
- A student with a card I-688, I-688A, I-688B (Employment Authorization)
- An applicant under the "Voluntary Departure Under the Family Unity Program" (effective 1997-98)
- Undocumented.
