**Subject:** Board of Trustees meeting report, September 21, 2016

Hello:

In an effort to help the campus community stay informed about actions taken during governance meetings, I'm pleased to share a report from last night's Board of Trustees meeting.

- The meeting was a board study session relating to the college's strategic planning process. The board discussed the goals it will set for Superintendent-President Vurdien (and, by extension, the college), and also began considering a list of goals it would set for the board itself.
- The board discussed modifying the list of goals [in the board packet](#) (starting on p. 90) by focusing on educational quality, fiscal responsibility, strategic communication, workforce development, non-tuition student expenses, and campus collegiality. Further action relating to the goals of the college will be taken at a future board meeting.
- In its sole business item, the board unanimously approved the college's Accreditation Follow-Up Report, clearing the final hurdle to the document's submission to the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges next week. The college expects to host an ACCJC delegation to discuss the follow-up report in detail before November 10.
- In his public report, Superintendent-President Vurdien announced that PCC has been invited to apply to a grant program at the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation designed to identify community colleges with a high potential of achieving improvements in completion and equity. If chosen to participate, PCC could receive a grant of up to \$630,000 over four years and take part in a network with a wide range of partners, including the Aspen Institute College Excellence Program.

**II. OPEN SESSION**

The meeting was called to order at 4:02 p.m.

**A. ANNOUNCEMENTS AND RECOGNITIONS**

Dr. Vurdien introduced Dr. Cynthia Olivo and Brock Klein who will be discussing the Aspen award; they have been working diligently on the application.

**B. PUBLIC COMMENT ON NON-AGENDA ITEMS**

There was no public comment.

**C. PRESIDENT'S REPORT**

Dr. Vurdien presented Dr. Cynthia Olivo and Brock Klein to speak about the Aspen Award. Dr. Olivo said they have been working diligently on the application. She reached out to the Aspen Institute to get more information and we have since qualified. At that time, PCC was number 600 out of 1200.

Aspen Award looks at the number of associate degrees given each year. They look at equity issues, labor outcome, assessment data and completion data. Based on the review, PCC has been named one of ten finalists for the 2017 Aspen Prize for Community College Excellence. This is an incredible accomplishment and it's a time to celebrate the accomplishments of our students.

The Aspen Institute will be here at PCC September 27<sup>th</sup> -28<sup>th</sup> for extensive meetings with administration.

3. Recommendation to approve the provisional budget recommended by the Finance & Investment Committee

**MOTION:** ON MOTION OF Mr. Schield and seconded by Ms. Pitzer, the Executive Committee voted by a unanimous vote (Sarni, Gregory, Bell, Potes-Fellow, Pitzer, Scott, Schield, and Winter) of the eight members present to approve the expenditures

Mr. Winter pointed out on pg. 7 the \$300K is the amount from KPCC to be redirected into the general fund as opposed to restricted. This is a 5 year budget. The College is fronting the amount now and the Foundation will only pay the college back the amount used for Foundation activities versus the amount used to raise funds for the College.

**E. REPORTS AND PROJECTS**

1. PCC Foundation President's Report –  
Mr. Sarni mentioned a few things from the last meeting in regards to the distribution of the funds from the Southern California Public Radio and the contract negotiation with the college. This contract is a 5 year term, which expires the end of September. Mr. Sarni pointed out that these two items go hand in hand. One depends on the other and that both are well underway. He also mentioned that Committee assignments are underway and will be completed soon.

2. Executive Director's Report –  
Ms. Abram explained that the development report and the campaign report will be grouped all in one. This type of report will become a standard in the Foundation Executive and Board of Directors meeting packets. This report will also show the donations on a monthly basis, which include both unrestricted and restricted.

Ms. Abram asked the committee to look at the reports and to help identify individuals who are not on the lists that should be asked to be part of the President's Circle.

Since Ms. Davis has started working on this major gifts campaign, Ms. Abram has had over 30 meetings with donors. The feasibility study has changed since the first time it was done during the Gala. The initiatives have been updated. The latest conversations have exhibited a sense of respect and appreciation for PCC from the community. Ms. Abram expressed how the efforts of the Foundation Board and staff are going in the right direction. The timing for this campaign is right.

Feedback from the meetings is that the Scholarships and CTE objectives are preferred over Athletics and the Arts, which are less supported from the community.

Ms. Abram reported that the Promise Program was be part of the Scholarship initiative. Dr. Giugni and Dr. Storti were immediately identified to be co-chairs of this committee.

3. Financials –  
Mr. Winter said we are only two months in the new fiscal year and the investment revenue is \$46K, which is up 4%.
4. Director of Operation's Report –  
Ms. McPeak expressed her excitement of the Foundation staff doing a music video for Academic Works. She presented the video to the committee.




## Pasadena City College Foundation Asset Allocation

### Long-term Funds - Schwab\*


