PROPOSAL FROM THE 1 2 PASADENA CITY COLLEGE FACULTY ASSOCIATION 3 TO THE 4 PASADENA AREA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT 5 August 11, 2022 6 7 The collective bargaining proposal presented herein by the Pasadena Area Community College 8 District to the Pasadena City College Faculty Association and is expressly made pursuant to the 9 Education Employment Relations Act and the Collective Bargaining Contract between the parties. 10 The following article shall be deemed to remain unchanged in the Collective Bargaining Agreement except as set forth below: 11 12 13 ARTICLE 174 (NEW) **REASSIGNED TIME** 14 15 174.1 Full-time faculty may be presented the opportunity to perform certain tasks while on 16 17 reassigned time from contractual duties. A reassigned time position will be 18 compensated pro-rata to the percentage of the employee's weekly assignment on 19 campus. 20 21 **14.1.1** Reassigned time may be used in the Fall and Spring semesters. The 22 assignment must be approved by the primary supervising manager. All 23 reassigned time positions shall be voluntary and shall not interfere with the 24 employee's non-released time contractual responsibilities. 25 26 14.1.2 Reassigned time assignments may be approved for up to two years. 27 Nothing precludes a full-time faculty member from re-applying after 28 serving in a reassigned time assignment. Exceptions may be made for 29 grant-funded positions. 30 31 174.2 The appropriate manager will develop a list of performance expectations that are 32 relevant to the assignment. These expectations will include, but are not limited to, the purpose of the assignment, objectives, expected outcomes and deliverables, 33 34 planned timelines, the percentage of the contractual load for the assignment, and the 35 scheduled hours for each week dedicated to the projects. These expectations will 36 provide the basis for the faculty member's performance evaluation. The evaluation of 37 released time is independent of the evaluations specified in the contract and relates 38 only to the position specified. 39 40 174.3 All eligible employees and the Faculty Association shall be notified ten (10) business days during Fall and Spring semesters in advance of all reassigned time positions 41 via a job description that will include a description of the position, duties, knowledge 42 43 and experience required, the amount of reassigned time and the duration of the 44 position. 45 174.4 For positions other than those elected by faculty, a selection committee will be 46 47 constituted to screen, select candidates to interview, and make a recommendation on the successful candidate to the Vice President of Instruction or Vice President of 48 Student Services. The selection committee will consist of five members: two 49 50 administrators (the supervising manager and another administrator chosen by the

appropriate Vice President) and three faculty members two of whom will be selected

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	by the Academic Senate and one by the Faculty Association.
1 <u>74</u> .5	The selection committee will interview all applicants and make a recommendation on who should be selected for the reassigned position. The final decision on the selected faculty member for the reassignment will be made by the Vice President of Instruction or Student Services (as appropriate). The supervising manager will evaluate the reassigned faculty member each year.
1 <u>74</u> .6	The District will publish on the campus web site by the second week of each semester a complete list of current reassigned time assignments including the position, individual occupying and supervisor of the position, term, and percentage reassigned. Also published will be a current list of position openings.
14.7	Resignation and Removal
	complete the assignment, a new faculty member shall be selected by the appropriate administrator, in consultation with the Academic Senate President, to serve for the remainder of the assignment immediately through the following process: The District shall send an e-mail to all faculty. Interested faculty have 3 business days to express interest. The candidates will be interviewed by one administrators, one faculty selected by Academic Senate and one selected by Faculty Association. 14.7.2 A faculty member on reassigned time may resign at the end of an academic term. A written resignation must be submitted to the appropriate administrator thirty (30) working days prior to the effective date of resignation. 14.7.3 An employee receiving a less than satisfactory evaluation may be removed
	from the assignment.
	14.7.4 Nothing precludes an employee removed or who resigns from a reassigned time assignment from being selected for a future reassigned time assignment.
