1 COUNTER PROPOSAL FROM THE 2 PASADENA AREA COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT TO 3 THE PASADENA CITY COLLEGE POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION 4 5 **August 18, 2025** 6 7 The collective bargaining proposals presented herein by the Pasadena Area Community College District to the Pasadena City College Police Officers Association is expressly made pursuant to the 8 9 Educational Employment Relations Act and the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the 10 parties. 11 12 The following articles shall be deemed to remain unchanged in the Collective Bargaining Agreement 13 except as set forth below: 14 15 **ARTICLE 15 HOLIDAYS** 16 17 15.1 Holidays for which employees covered by this Agreement may be eligible are: 18 19 New Year's Eve Day 20 New Year's Day 21 Martin Luther King Jr. Day 22 Lincoln Day 23 Washington Day 24 Cesar Chavez Day 25 Spring Vacation Day 26 Memorial Day 27 Juneteenth Independence Day 28 29 Labor Day 30 California Admission Day 31 Veteran's Day 32 Thanksgiving Day Friday after Thanksgiving 33 Christmas Eve Day 34 35 Christmas Day Three (3) Days Winter Holiday 36 37 15.2 Holidays shall be observed on the dates shown on the District's calendar as approved by 38 the Board of Trustees. 39 40 15.3 When a holiday or alternative observance day falls on a scheduled workday, a regular full-41 time employee covered by this Agreement shall receive such holiday at his or her full 42 regular rate of pay for all hours worked. Additionally, unit members who worked on a 43 holiday will receive overtime for all hours worked at one and a half times their regular rate 44 of pay plus substitute holiday straight time pay for all hours worked. When a holiday or 45 alternative observance day falls outside the employee's scheduled workweek, the 46 employee shall receive compensation for eight (8) hours at his or her straight time rate. for eight (8) hours at his or her straight-time rate 47 48 49 15.4 All probationary and permanent employees who are part of the classified service shall be entitled to holiday pay if they are in a paid status during any portion of the workday 50 51 immediately proceeding or following the holiday. 52

If an employee is required to work on a holiday, he or she shall receive compensation at

the rate of one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) times his or her regular rate of pay for each hour worked on such holiday in addition to regular holiday pay.

15.6 If for any academic year during the term of this Agreement, the Governing Board of the District determines that California Admission Day is to become a scheduled day of instruction on the District's academic calendar, such holiday shall be converted to a floating holiday for employees in the unit. An employee's utilization of such holiday must create at least a three-day (3) weekend within the academic year in which the holiday accrues; is subject to the employee providing his or her supervisor with not less than thirty (30) calendar days' notice of the anticipated date of such holiday; and Is subject to the scheduling needs of the District. Any floating holiday must be used in the academic year in which it accrues, and will not carry over into the next academic year. The floating holiday shall be administrated in accordance with Section 15.4 through 15.6 above.
